## Erratum

### Erratum: Antimicrobial susceptibility profile & resistance mechanisms of Global Antimicrobial Resistance Surveillance System (GLASS) priority pathogens from India

In the article titled “Antimicrobial susceptibility profile & resistance mechanisms of Global Antimicrobial Resistance Surveillance System (GLASS) priority pathogens from India”, published on pages 87-96, Issue 2, Volume 149 in Indian J Med Res<sup>[1]</sup>, the term “>0.25 mg/l” is incorrectly mentioned as “>1 mg/l” on page 89, 17<sup>th</sup> line, under first paragraph.

The correct statement should be read as “For meropenem, two new breakpoints have been introduced, the breakpoints for meningitis are susceptible  $\leq 0.25$  and resistant  $> 0.25$  mg/l, and for non-meningitis  $\leq 2$  and  $> 2$  mg/l, respectively<sup>29</sup>.”
