



Supplementary Fig. 1. A heatmap depicting the presence of genes in infants. The genes have been categorised into respective classes. The presence of genes is marked by pink (birth), teal (6 wk), yellow (14 wk) and purple (36 wk). The dark grey boxes indicate infants carrying genes across multiple classes at a particular time point. The last column is a colour scale that indicates the number of genes carried by an infant at a given time point.
